
Blossoming majestically in a sea of incredible color.

Sightseeing Car



Enjoy a gentle ride to see panoramic views of the expansive park starting from the car stop at the foot of the hill up to the highest point on the hill. Return fees are just 300 yen for adults and 150 yen for children (aged 12 and under).

2 Go-karts



Have fun driving a one-person or two-person go-kart around the beautiful park views. Fees are 300 yen for a one-person cart or 500 yen for a two-person cart (1 lap).

Fishing Pond



Fishing pond that is fun for all the family, young or old! Experience the excitement of fishing for big rainbow trout! Hourly fees are 1,500 yen for adults, 1,000 yen for children (aged 12 and under).
