
Blossoming majestically in a sea of incredible color.

Shibazakura Park Facility Information

1 Sightseeing Car



Enjoy a gentle ride from the foot of the hill to the top and take in panoramic views of the expansive park. The return fare is 400 yen for people 13 years and up and 200 yen for people aged 6 to 12.

2 Go-karts



Hop in a one-person or two-person go-kart and take a thrilling ride around an 820m circuit through the beautiful fields of moss phlox. One lap is 400 yen for a one-person go-kart or 600 yen for a two-person go-kart

3 Fishing Pond



The fishing pond is fun for the whole family, young and old! With an abundance of trout, you're sure to get a bite or two! An hour of fishing is 1,800 yen for people 13 years and up and 1,200 yen for people 12 years and younger.

4 Bungalows



Uniquely shaped 7 or 8-berth bungalows are available next to the campsite if you're keen to stay the night. 5,000 yen per bungalow per night. (July 1 to September 30)

5 Day Trip Hot Spring/Foot Bath



The "Shibazakura no Yu" hot springs now has a new footbath which is open for use during the Shibazakura Festival
